Essential Packing List

1	Travel Documents & Essentials (Carry-On Must-Haves!)
	Passport & Copies (Keep an extra copy in your luggage & digital copies on your phone.) Travel Insurance & Emergency Contact Info
	Student ID (Some attractions offer student discounts!)
	Credit/Debit Cards (Make sure they work internationally & notify your bank.)
	Small Crossbody Bag or Anti-Theft Backpack
	Phone & Charger (+ a portable battery pack!)
	Travel Adapter (Europe uses different plugs – bring a universal adapter!)
2	Clothing: Stay Comfortable & Stylish
	Light Layers: Summer in Spain & France can be warm, but evenings can be cool. Pack eathable tops and a light jacket.
□ sh	Comfortable Walking Shoes: Expect LOTS of walking! Bring 2 pairs of comfortable pes (sneakers & casual sandals).
	Casual & Dressy Outfits: One nicer outfit for special dinners or events.
	Rain Jacket or Compact Umbrella: Sudden rain showers can happen, especially in Paris!
	Sleepwear & Undergarments: Pack enough but don't overdo it – you can wash on the go .
	Swimsuit & Flip-Flops: If you plan to enjoy the beaches in Barcelona!
3	Toiletries & Health Essentials
	Travel-Size Toiletries: Shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant (must be TSA-approved if in carry-on). Medications: Bring any prescriptions in original bottles + a small first aid kit. Sunscreen & Sunglasses: The sun in Spain can be strong!
	Lip Balm & Moisturizer: Flights and air-conditioned hotels can dry out your skin.
	Laundry Bag: A small foldable bag to separate dirty clothes.
4	Travel Gadgets & Extras
	Portable Charger & Charging Cables (You'll be taking lots of photos!)
	Notebook & Pen (Great for jotting down new words & experiences.)
	Lightweight Backnack (For day tring & excursions)

☐ Earplugs & Sleep Mask (For the plane or noisy hotel stays.)☐ Refillable Water Bottle (Stay hydrated while exploring!)
What to Expect: Weather in Spain & France
 Paris (June-July): Mild to warm (65-80°F), occasional rain showers. Barcelona & Madrid: Hot (80-95°F), lots of sunshine, dry climate. Packing Tip: Bring light, breathable clothes, sunglasses, and comfortable shoes for long walks!
Packing Like a Minimalist: Light Packing Tips
 Use Packing Cubes – Keep clothes organized and save space. Roll, Don't Fold – Rolling clothes helps prevent wrinkles and saves space. Limit Shoes to 2-3 Pairs – One comfortable pair, one casual, and one optional dressy pair. Check Airline Baggage Rules – Avoid overpacking and extra fees by checking size & weight limits. Wear Bulkier Items on the Plane – Jackets and sneakers take up too much luggage space!
